



We have been in the commercial cattle business since 1970 and have chosen seedstock that work well for us in the heavy, black soils of Noxubee County and the hot summers and high humidity of Pearl River County. Five of these heifers are 7/8 Brangus. The remaining 11 heifers are Brangus sired with most out of ½ Hereford and ½ Brahman dams, the "Queens of the South". They are the product of 19 years of using calving ease and high growth EPDs as part of our bull selection criteria. Our cows are selected to have good attitudes, be easy-keeping and have high production. Of the last 1,187 cows and heifers that have calved on our ranch, we have only assisted with 2 deliveries – one was backwards and the other was out of an obese heifer (that was too lazy to push). Pregnancy checked on 8/2/18. Heifers are up-to-date on all recommended by veterinarian. Heifers have also been vaccinated for Brucellosis and Scour Guard. Heifers have been de-wormed. Heifers are bred to low birth weight, calving ease, Town Creek Brangus bulls.


